31- preservation

keeping something the same or preventing it from being damaged or destroyed

koruma, muhafaza
the preservation of peace
the preservation of wildlife

32- accuracy

how correct or exact something is

doğruluk, güvenilirlik
The new system should help to improve the accuracy of weather forecasts

33- objectivity

the fact of being based on facts and not influenced by personal beliefs or feelings:

tarafsızlık, nesnellik

Surely true objectivity in a critic is impossible?

We should not lose our objectivity as we respond to the attack.

the state or quality of being objective and fair:

The newspaper has a reputation for objectivity and fairness.

the quality of being able to make a decision or judgment in a fair way that is not influenced by personal feelings or beliefs:

He questioned his manager's objectivity.

An auditor must always give the appearance of objectivity and impartiality.

34- diversity

a situation in which many different types of things or people are included in something

çeşitlilik, farklılık, çok türlülük
ethnic diversity

35- decline

a situation in which something becomes less in amount, importance, quality, or strength

düşüş, azalma, gerileme
*a steady **decline** in sales/standards*

36- distribution

the activity or work of supplying something or giving something out to people

taksim, dağıtım
the sale and distribution of DVDs

the way something is divided and shared in a group or area

paylaşım, dağılım
The distribution of wealth was very unequal.

37- demand

a need for something to be sold or supplied

talep
*There's an increasing **demand** for cheap housing.*

wanted or needed in large numbers

çok istenen, rağbet gören, revaçta olan
Good teachers are always in demand.

38- restriction

a rule or law that limits what people can do

kısıtlama, sınırlama, tahdit

There are **restrictions on** how many goods you can bring into the country.

parking restrictions

39- benefit

something that helps you or gives you an advantage

kâr, fayda, yarar, çıkar, kazanç

I've **had the benefit of** a happy childhood.

money that the government gives to people who are sick, poor, not working, etc

düşkünlere yapılan devlet yardımı
unemployment benefit

40- indication

a sign showing that something exists or is likely to be true

belirti, işaret, iz, alamet, emare

[+ (that)] There

are **strong indications** that the case will be referred to the Court of Appeal.

a sign showing what someone means or what they intend to do

İşaret, gösterge

Helen's face **gave no indication of** what she was thinking.

41- belongings

the things that you own

şahsi eşyalar

I took a few **personal belongings** with me.

42- pattern

a particular way that something is often done or repeated

büçüm, şekil, tarz

behaviour patterns

a design of lines, shapes, colours, etc

desen, motif, tasarım

a drawing or shape that helps you to make something

örnek çizim, taslak tasarım, patron

a dress pattern

43- compliment

something that you say or do to show praise or admiration for someone

iltifat, övgü, kur, kompliman

She was always **paying him compliments**.

used by someone to express good wishes when they give you something free, for example in a restaurant

müessesemizin iyi dilekleriyle; sevgi ve selamlarımızla, saygılarımıza

Please accept this champagne with the compliments of the manager.

44- invention

something that has been designed or created for the first time

icat, buluş

45- service

help that you get in a place such as a shop, restaurant, or hotel

hizmet, servis, bakma, ilgilendirme

The food was nice, but the service wasn't very good.

a system that supplies something that people need

servis, hizmet

financial/medical services

electricity/water services

They **provide** a free bus **service** from the station.
